Here is a little bit more about our program: Skate.Now was launched in 2015 and we have helped over 150 children and adults learn the basics to skateboarding. We are based out of New Jersey and we have taught clients ranging from age 4 to age 65 all along the east coast. Skate.Now has partnered with multiple non-profit organizations to host a number of charitable events and teambuilding workshops. We just returned from our trip to Nicaragua where we donated skateboard equipment and lessons to schools in order to help transform underdeveloped communities.
